A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute an Agreement with the Ky. Transportation Cabinet (KYTC), delegating responsibility for operation and maintenance costs for traffic signals and electrical traffic control devices on the State Primary Rd. System in Fayette County, which shall be reimbursed by KYTC up to \$426,000. [Div. of Traffic Engineering, Neal]

Authorization to renew the Annual MOA between the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) and the LFUCG Division of Traffic Engineering for the operation and maintenance of traffic signals and electrical traffic control devices on the State Primary Road System at \$396,000.00, along with an additional \$30,000.00 associated with replacing the Lane Use Control (LUC) signs on US 27. This Agreement is not to exceed the reimbursement cost of \$426,000.00 for the effective period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. (L0549-24) (Neal/Albright)
