The existing Agreement is expiring and the Division of Enhanced 911 needs this software and support service to provide a single database for 911 location records for Lexington and counties in the Central Kentucky 911 Network. Section 2 - That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$46,732.00, be and hereby is approved for payment to 911 Datamaster, from account #4204-505602-76102 (\$10,181.00), from account #4204-505603-76102 (\$4,000.00), and #4205-505602-76102 (\$32,551.00) pursuant to the terms of the Renewal Agreement.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
