BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized to execute an Agreement, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, with Lexington Freedom Train with LexArts Inc. as Fiscal Agent, to fund a public art project, with funds from the Percent for Art Fund, through the Public Art Commission’s Collaborative Grant Program, in an amount not to exceed \$245,000.00.

Section 2 - That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$245,000.00, be and hereby is approved for payment to LexArts Inc. from account #2614-134201-71299, pursuant to the terms of the Agreement.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
