An Ordinance amending the Classified Civil Service authorized strength by abolishing one (1) position of Administrative Specialist Sr., Grade 516N, and creating one (1) position of Administrative Specialist Principal, Grade 518N, and reclassifying the incumbent in the Dept. of Public Safety, effective the beginning of the next pay period following passage of Council. [Div. of Human Resources, Maxwell]

Authorization to abolish one (1) classified position of Administrative Specialist Sr. (Grade 516N) and create one (1) classified position of Administrative Specialist Principal (Grade 518N); reclassifying the incumbent within the Department of Public Safety, effective beginning of pay period following passage of Council.
