An Ordinance amending the authorized strength by creating one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Traffic Signal Technician Sr., Grade 515N, in the Div. of Traffic Engineering; creating one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Coding Compliance Specialist, Grade 516N, in the Div. of Fire and Emergency Services; abolishing one (1) vacant Classified Position of Planning Manager, Grade 526E, and creating one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Administrative Officer, Grade 523E, in the Div. of Planning, and creating one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Technical Specialist, Grade 515N, in the Div. of Parks and Recreation, effective July 1, 2021. [Div. of Human Resources, Maxwell]

Authorization to amend the Classified Civil Service authorized strength by abolishing and creating positions as approved in the FY 2022 Budget process, to become effective July 1, 2021.
