A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept an additional Grant award from the United States Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), for the Community Development Block Grant Program (\$35,436) and the Home Investment Partnerships Program (\$18,000) in FY 2021, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of any additional funds as a local match, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. Authorization to accept award of additional Federal funds in the 2021 Consolidated Plan from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) in the amount of \$35,436 and HOME Investment Partnerships Program in the amount of \$18,000. capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget established herein.
