

Legislation Text

An Ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 22-79, pertaining to the Mayor's authority to transfer the unencumbered balance of Grants, and providing that the Mayor may, upon specific authorization by Ordinance or Resolution, transfer the unencumbered balance of any account within the same Grant Budget so long as the scope and intent of the Grant is not significantly changed. [Council Office, Maynard]

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN

COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That Ordinance No. 22-79 be and hereby is repealed in its entirety.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of this Section, the Mayor, as Chief Executive Officer

of the Urban County Government, May, from time to time, be authorized by Ordinance or Resolution

to transfer the unencumbered balance of any account within the same Grant Budget, so long as the

scope and intent of the Grant is not significantly changed.

Section 3 - That weekly summaries of Grant Budget transfers made pursuant to any such

Ordinance or Resolution will be furnished the Office of the Council of the Lexington-Fayette Urban

County Government.

Section 4 - That the provisions contained herein are in addition to all other means of amending

any Grant Budget, and are not a limitation on such means.

Section 5 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage.
