A Resolution authorizing the Dept. of Environmental Quality and Public Works, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to purchase services for the removal, redesign, and reinstallation of a portion of the sprinkler system at the Materials Recycling Facility, from Landmark Sprinkler, Inc., a sole source provider, and authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute any necessary Agreement with Landmark Sprinkler, Inc., related to the procurement, at a cost estimated not to exceed \$108,500. [Div. of Waste Management, Thurman]

Authorization to accept Landmark Sprinkler as a sole source for the removal, redesign and reinstallation of a major portion of the sprinkler system it installed in 2019 at the LFUCG Material Recycling Facility (MRF) due to a major upgrade of the system.
