A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute a four-year lease Agreement with Quadient Leasing USA, Inc., through Central Business Systems, Inc., and authorizing her to execute any other documents related to this lease, for Electronic Return Receipt Software for the Dept. of General Services, at a cost not to exceed \$1,269.42 in FY 2022. Authorization to execute a lease Agreement with Quadient Leasing USA Inc. (through Central Business Systems) for web-based software to manage delivery of certified mailings by the government center's mailroom, at a cost of \$2538.84 annually. Section 2 - That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$1,269.42 in FY 2022, be and hereby is approved for payment to Quadient Leasing USA, Inc., and/or Central Business Systems, Inc., from account #1101-707101-0001-71303, pursuant to the terms of the Lease Agreement and any related documents, with future fiscal years (\$2,538.84, annually) subject to the appropriation of sufficient funds.
