An Ordinance amending the authorized strength by creating one (1) classified position of Information Officer, Grade 518E, in the Div. of Government Communications; abolishing one (1) unclassified position of Public Service Worker P/T, Grade 507N, in the Div. of Facilities and Fleet Management; and creating one (1) classified position of Public Service Worker, Grade 507N, in the Div. of Facilities and Fleet Management, all effective July 1, 2022. [Div. of Human Resources, Walters]

Authorization to amend the classified and Unclassified Civil Service authorized strength, abolishing and creating positions as approved in the FY 2023 Budget process, to become effective July 1, 2022.
