A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to accept an additional award of \$89,857.30 in Federal funds under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) from the Ky. Cabinet for Health and Family Services, Dept. for Community Based Services, in order to support child care expenses in the Extended School Program at the Div. of Parks and Recreation, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget. 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Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be

and hereby is authorized and directed to accept an additional award of \$89,857.30 of federal funds

under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) from the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family

Services, Department for Community Based Services, in order to support child care expenses in the

Extended School Program at the Division of Parks and Recreation, the acceptance of which does not

obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 97-21, the Mayor is hereby

authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer

the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or

capital account appropriation within the Grant budget established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
