An Ordinance amending the authorized strength by creating one (1) Classified Civil Service Position of Recreation Supervisor, Grade 514E, in the Dept. of Social Services and creating one (1) Unclassified Civil Service Position of Administrative Specialist Sr., Grade 516N, in the Office of the Mayor, all effective July 1, 2022. [Div. of Human Resources, Walters] Authorization to amend the classified and Unclassified Civil Service authorized strength by creating positions as approved in the FY 2023 Budget process, to become effective July 1, 2022.
