A Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute and submit a Grant Application to the Ky. Justice and Public Safety Cabinet seeking an award of \$99,038 in Federal funds from the 2022 Project Safe Neighborhood Grant, which shall be used for the purchase of computer hardware and database software, to provide any additional information requested in connection with this Grant Application, and to accept this Grant if the application is approved, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds, and authorizing the Mayor to transfer unencumbered funds within the Grant Budget for these Grants. Authorization to submit a Grant Application and accept award if offered to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet for the 2022 Project Safe Neighborhood (PSN) Grant in the amount of \$99,038. No matching funds required. (L0228-24) (Weathers/Armstrong)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute and submit the Grant Application, which is attached hereto and

incorporated herein by reference, to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet for the 2022 Project Safe Neighborhood Grant, seeking \$99,038.00 in Federal funds, which shall be used for the purchase of computer hardware and database software, and to provide any additional information requested in connection with this Grant Application, and to accept this Grant if the application is approved, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Section 7-48 of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Code of Ordinances, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant Budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
