


RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AGAINST THE
LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT


I, Patrick Murray (name), of Lexington (city),

employment assignment for security or law enforcement purposes, and am prohibited to
sale or transfer the retired police canine to another public safety entity.
