SUBJECT: RFP#13-2022 for the Sanitary Sewer Capacity Assurance Program (CAP) Consulting Services

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Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of the agreement renewal between the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) and Stantec Consulting Services per CAP professional services Contract #164-2022 that in FY23 provided for agreement not to exceed \$600,000 (Resolution #312-2022) plus allowed for up to four (4) agreement renewals.

Purpose of Request

As provided in RFP#13-2022 and the agreement award Blue Sheet, the annual renewal of the Stantec Consulting Services agreement continues services that assist the Division of Water Quality meet the obligations of the Consent Decree requirement of a Capacity Assurance Program.

Project Cost in FY26 and in Future Budget Years

Per Resolution #31-2022 in FY23, the contracted amount was for \$600,000, but that amount covered two activity years; therefore, no renewal was utilized in FY24. The FY26 renewal is for \$300,000 and the FY25 renewal \$240,943.66—not the not to exceed amount of \$600,000 as provided in the resolution. The expectation is that the FY27 final renewal will be approximately the same reduced amount, and then the contract will have to be readvertised.
