## Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY26 (Class B Infrastructure) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for BBPH Properties, LLC, in the amount of \$113,800.00.

# Purpose of Request

The purpose of the project is to improve water quality in the uppermost part of the Wolf Run watershed by mitigating excessive algae in a commercial retention pond along Pasadena Drive. The project elements include removal of invasive species surrounding the pond ( $\pm 0.4$  acre), installation of a solar powered aerating diffuser, and installation of wetland plantings – native trees, shrubs, wildflowers and sedges ( $\pm 0.2$  acre), which will help improve the native tree canopy. The project also has a stormwater education component in the form of permanent educational signage installed near the project for the general public to learn about water quality.

# Project Cost in FY26 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved for FY 2026 funding by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$113,800.00.
